**Notes regarding Math Summer Work:**

Although all students rising to Grades 7– 11 are encouraged to work on packets and with the provided resources, *only the following courses will REQUIRE students to hand in the packets for a grade.*

- Accelerated Math 8
- Algebra I *Honors*
- Geometry *Honors*
- Algebra II *Honors*
- Pre- Calculus
- Pre-Calculus *Honors*
- Statistics\* (Mr. Sweeney)
- Calculus (Honors & AP)\* (Mr. Sweeney)
- AP Statistics\* (Mr. Coster)

*\*Students enrolled in these courses MUST see the teachers for a textbook.*

*Summer math packets are to be completed for the class that students **will be attending next year** (2018-2019), not the class in which he/she is currently enrolled. While the review and application of the material covered in the summer assignment will be at the teacher's discretion, all students will receive a grade on the packet and will be assessed on prerequisite concepts during the first week of school.*
