The Cedar Grove High School and Memorial Middle School Social Studies, English, and Mathematics Departments have compiled summer assignments for all students. *Assignments will be graded* and should be turned in to the students' teachers on the first day of school in September.

Summer work has already been discussed in individual classrooms. In addition to required courses in Social Studies and Math, all students enrolled in an Advanced Placement (AP) class in other disciplines are also expected to complete an assignment.

**MIDDLE SCHOOL:**

**There will be no English Department Summer Reading assignments for Grades 5-8.**

Instead, students entering Grades 5-8 will be required to complete a short Summer Assignment for their **Social Studies** class *for a grade*.

Although all students rising to Grades 7 and Grade 8 are encouraged to work on the provided **Math** packets to help retain prerequisite material, ***only the Accelerated Math 7 and Accelerated Math 8 courses will REQUIRE students to hand in the packets for a grade.***

**Students ENTERING the following Social Studies classes will have a graded Summer Assignment:**

**Students ENTERING only the following Mathematics classes will have a graded Summer Skills Packet:**

Although all students rising to Grades 9 - 12 are encouraged to work on packets and with the provided resources, ***only the following courses will REQUIRE students to hand in the packets for a grade.***

- Geometry *Honors*
- Algebra II *Honors*
- Pre- Calculus
- Pre-Calculus *Honors*
- Statistics\* (Mrs. Rack)
- Statistics *Honors*\* (Mrs. Rack)

- Calculus *Honors*\* (Mr. Sweeney)
- AP Statistics\* (Mr. Coster)
