NHS CANDIDATE SELECTION PROCEDURES

- Step 1:** Academic Eligibility – All students who have maintained a 3.8 (No Rounding) GPA through their second semester of their junior year will be eligible to apply for admission into the National Honor Society.
Note: GPA eligibility does not guarantee admission.
- Step 2:** Candidate Notification – All students who have met the GPA requirement by their second semester of their junior year will receive an invitation to apply for induction into the National Honor Society. They will also receive a Candidate Form that will allow each candidate the opportunity to highlight the work they have done outside of the classroom demonstrating their capacity to fulfill the 4 pillars of the National Honor Society (scholarship, leadership, character, and service).
- Step 3:** Faculty Input Collection – A faculty council will be assembled containing members from multiple academic disciplines. The council will review the Candidate Forms submitted by each candidate seeking induction into the National Honor Society. Candidate selection for membership will be based on the council’s deliberation and determination as to whether a candidate has the capacity to fulfill all of the chapter requirements. This council will be facilitated by the adviser of the National Honor Society. A majority vote of the council is required for admission into the National Honor Society.
- Step 4:** Reporting of Results to the Principal – Prior to the notification of the selected members, the adviser of NHS will notify the principal of the council’s selections and non-selections.
- Step 5:** Notification – Candidates and their parents will be notified by letter indicating whether they have been selected for induction to the National Honor Society
