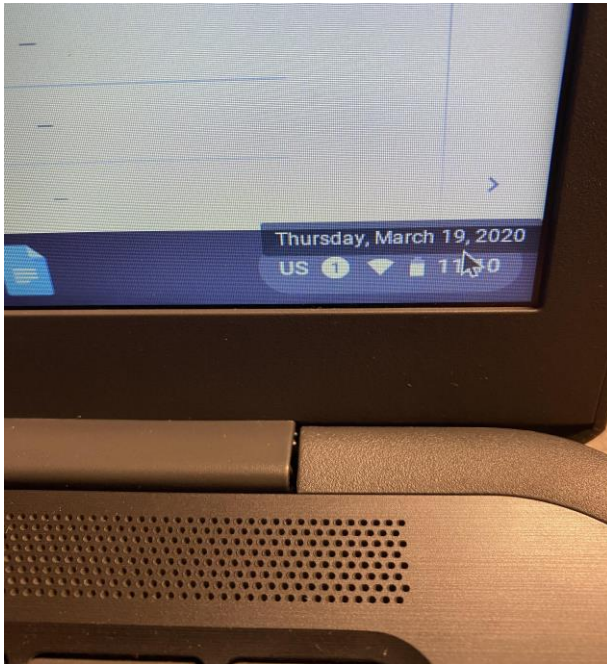


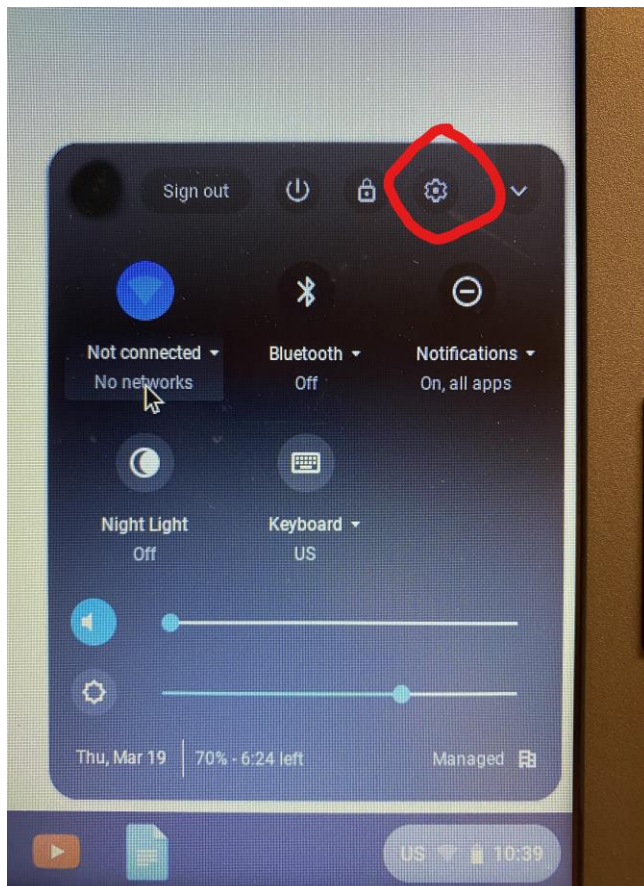
Staying connected to Wi-Fi with Chromebook

The following steps should help to keep your Chromebook connected to Wi-Fi at home.

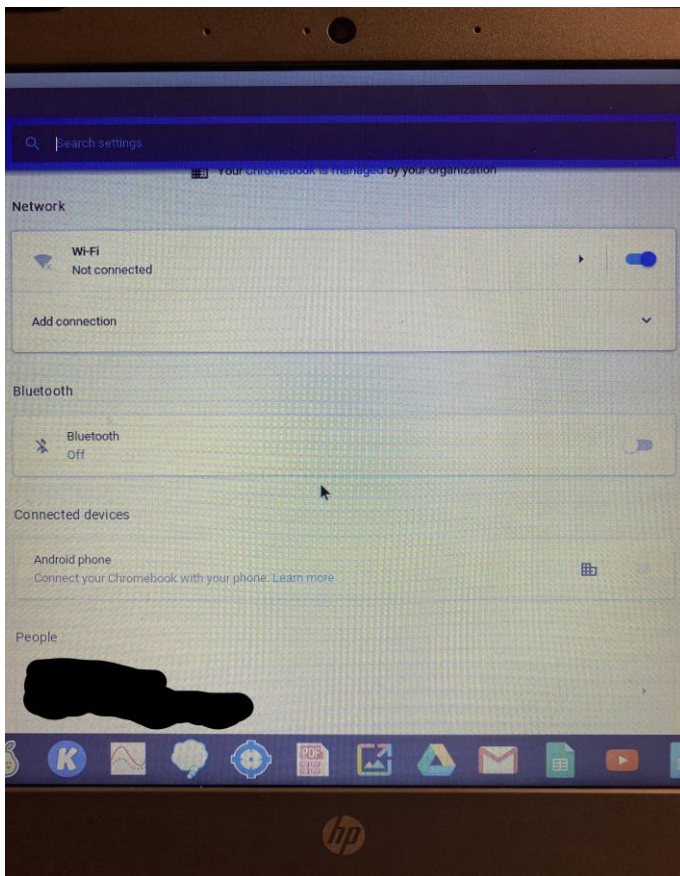
1. Click on the bubble where the time is showing along with other icons



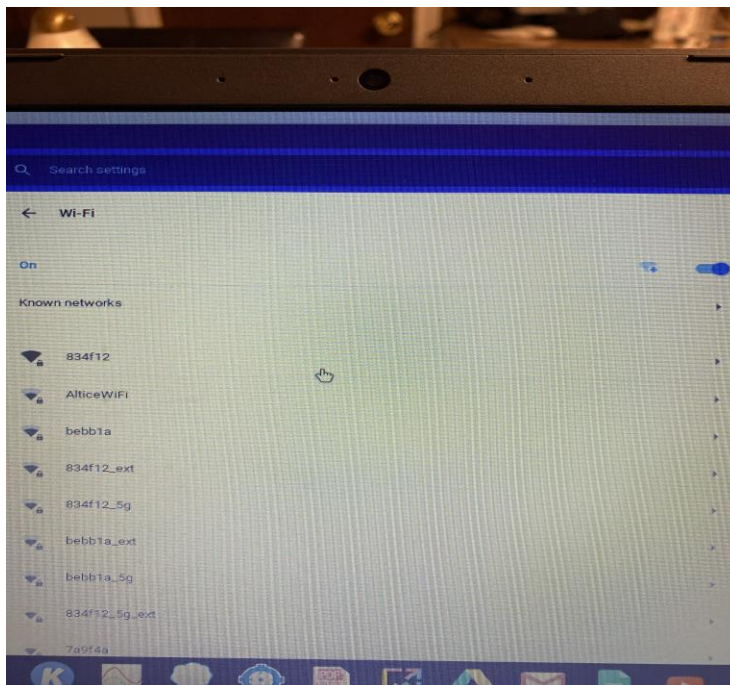
2. The following window will appear. Click on the gear icon on the top right circled in red.



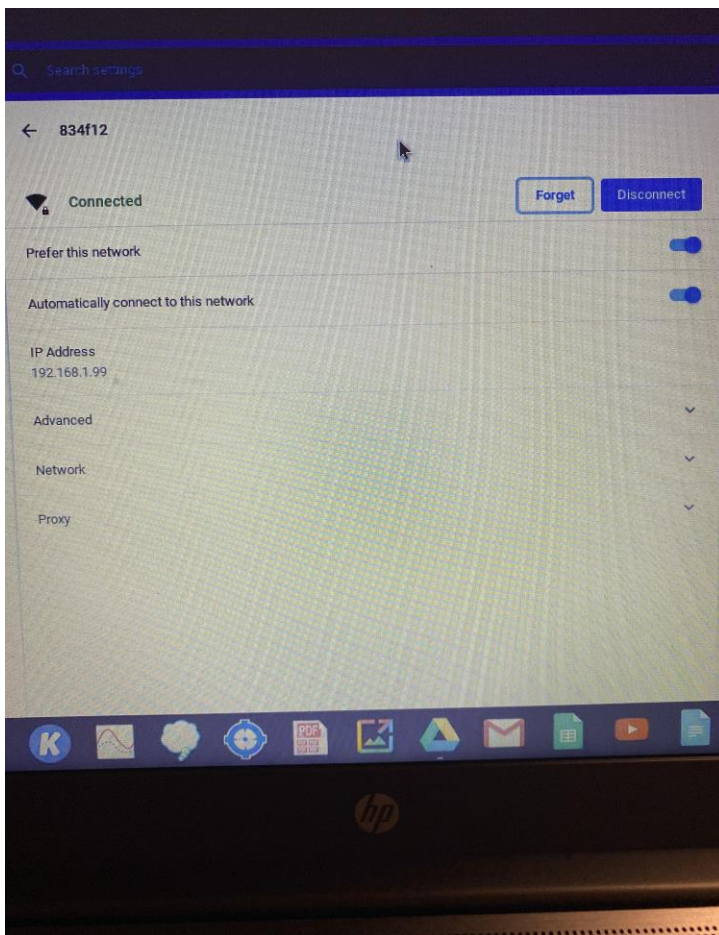
3. A new window will open showing you the following options. Click where it says Wi-Fi .



4. A new window appears showing a list of Wi-Fi networks available. If you are connected to a Wi-Fi you will see **Connected** under your Wi-Fi signal.
If you are not make sure to connect to your Wi-Fi. Once you see the word **Connected** under your Wi-Fi signal make sure to click it.



5. A new window appears showing you details about the Wi-Fi you are connected to.
Make sure that **Prefer this network** and **automatically connect to this network** are both checked. If it isn't click on each slider next to each category.



Now your Chromebook will stay connected to the network and automatically reconnect to your Wi-Fi
